Walk C To The Long Shop, Leiston

Over heath and farmland to the historically important birth place of assembly line production.

Can be muddy in places, not suitable for pushchairs or wheelchairs.

- Turn left out of reception, pass the Tee to hole 3 then take the signed path immediately afterwards on the left. Take care of golfers teeing off. Follow this path between course and The Meare. Enjoy the beautiful tranquillity by the water under the canopy of the trees.
- 2. The path meets a larger footway just after a small bungalow. Turn right between the buildings and continue at side of golf course until reaching the road. Cross the road and continue along the rough track until this bends to the left, here you continue along the smaller footpath. Soon after leaving the track a small gate is found, go through the gate and continue in the same direction.
- 3. A second gate is located at another multiple path junction, again go through the gate and continue in the same direction. Now heading into open farm land stay on the path between the two fields. When approaching a thin strip of woods join the sandy farm track and continue passing underneath the overhead power cables from Sizewell Power Station.
- 4. At an isolated pink cottage turn left along another farm track for a short distance, at a junction of pathways turn right going along an open field at the side of a school playing field. On reaching the end of the field turn left in front of the school, cross the recreation field and take the path that turns right along the far side.

- 5. This path takes you alongside the primary school, where at a service road you turn left in front of the school. Stay on this service road until reaching the tarmac road. Turn right at the road, then left, stay on this road until the crossroad with traffic lights, turn right. Just before the end of the road steps will be seen going into High Green, take these steps and go through High Green and into The Long Shop. Enjoy your visit.
- 6. Then return to Thorpeness Golf Club and Hotel by reversing this route

What you may see on the walk: -


Plants such as: - gorse, rhododendron, a variety of heathers.

Birds such: - nightjar, nightingale, warblers, linnets and many others

Mammals such as: - rabbits, deer, vole.

Reptiles such as: - adder, lizards.

Insects such as: - Dragonfly and butterfly.



Please follow the Countryside Code whilst on this walk, especially: -

- Take litter home with you
- Dogs to be kept on leads, horses are stabled adjacent to this walk, there are also working farms with livestock in the area
- Take dog excreta away to ensure others can enjoy the walk.
- Do not damage trees and other vegetation as these provide valuable habitat for the wild life.
- Care must be taken on the roads, they are relatively quiet but agricultural vehicles use them at all times of the day.
